Greenways Academy Academic Policies

Greenways Academy strives to ensure student success as well as comply with Missouri Course Action Program and Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education Learning Standards.

- Students are expected to work a minimum of 87 hours per semester per course and submit work for each course every week. The course syllabus provides pacing guidance.
- Weekly progress towards completion in a course is required. Attendance demonstrated
 through progress in the course, and weekly submission of completed work is required by
 state law. Students who have not submitted work for 5 consecutive school days are
 considered truant and truancy procedures can be begun. After 20 consecutive days of no
 progress, the student will be withdrawn from the Greenways Academy Program.
- Every student enrolled in online courses is required to communicate with their instructor a
 minimum of once weekly for instruction, review of assignments, testing, evaluation of
 student progress or other learning activities. Failure to do so may result in withdrawal from
 the Greenways Academy program, regardless of progress in course. Students must do this
 for every class they are enrolled in for the entire time they are enrolled in the course. The
 cell phone number/email address provided to the school at time of enrollment will be
 used for course communication. Communications from the teacher must be responded to
 promptly. Teachers will respond to communication from the student within 24 hours,
 excluding weekends and holidays.
